## Meeting Minutes of the Foundation of the Order of the Leaf

Item 1. - Report from Buildings and Grounds Committee Of the four potential sites which were located last year we are down to two, however we gained a new one.

Site 1 – Established Church- site currently off the market

Site 2 – Established Church, located in downtown Maysville and was rumored to be offered to the City of Maysville for \$400,000 before public outcry at the proposed use of "Flies Storage" caused the city council to negate their plans. Has a large sanctuary with some office space and nearly no parking or other grounds. This property can't decided what it's doing, on the market, off the market.. Once the congregation moves to their new building, maybe they will decide what to do with this property.

Site 3 – Residential and Commercial complex located near the downtown area of Maysville. Current land/building values of about \$130,000/acre in the area, this would need to be purchased and re-zoned and then cleared and rebuilt – estimated costs could negate this plan.

Site 4 – Established Church property – currently appears abandoned and is in horrible condition. Would require tremendous resources to repair or replace. Removed from our short list by the committee.

Site 5 – Established Residential complex located in downtown Maysville. This is currently a single family house on a little over two acres of land. It is currently on the market for about \$400,000 – and we would need rezoning to make it work for the Abbey. It could be a great location for Office space with an outdoor wedding chapel in the back. This is the current committee favorite.

We are, of course, awaiting more financial data and commitments before committing any resources towards any of these properties.
